During the 'Time of Prayer' there is the opportunity to move around the sanctuary and engage with 'prayer stations', which will be explained at the time. During Communion, we will be inviting everyone to come forward to receive at the front, if you are able, and we will serve in the pew anyone who cannot manage; again, instructions will be given. At the end, we'll all say The Grace together, which will appear on screen, as will the words for the Lord's Prayer.
