- 9.30 am this will be a half-hour, family-friendly service in the sanctuary. Anyone is welcome to attend. Resource packs are available each week for children and the message will be all-age.
- 11.00 am this will be a more regular service but with no all-age section. The resource packs will still be available, as the message in both services will follow the same Bible passage, and the creche room is still available.

We are also experimenting with moving the refreshments to 10.30 am over the summer period and so there will be no after-service refreshments following the 11.00 am service. We hope this will enable a time of fellowship even if people depart quickly afterwards to enjoy family time during these weeks. We will still have 10.15 am prayer each Sunday, so stay on, or come a little earlier, to share in this too.
