Welcome to our Evening Service

Our evening service is deliberately different in many ways to our morning service, allowing for space to linger in God's presence and respond to His preached Word. You will see in the order of service that we have a block of worship at the start – it's good to all stand together for the first hymn, if you can, but afterwards, please feel free to sit, dance, kneel, etc at any point; you don't need to stand for the whole time of praise. During the 'Time of Prayer' there is the opportunity to move around the sanctuary and engage with 'prayer stations', which will be explained at the time. During Communion, we will be inviting everyone to come forward to receive at the front, if you are able, and we will serve in the pew anyone who cannot manage; again, instructions will be given. At the end, we'll all say The Grace together, which will appear on screen, as will the words for the Lord's Prayer.
