Launch of CAP Money Course in Brightons

Christians Against Poverty (CAP) are a charity that Brightons supports in fighting debt and poverty in the Forth Valley area. This is done in partnership with local churches, working to see lives transformed. In addition to their debt advice service, they now run Money Management courses in cooperation with churches. Since its launch nationally they have helped thousands of people to budget, spend and save better. They believe that when people feel confident and equipped to manage their money well, they have greater financial resilience, healthier relationships and more opportunities to thrive. Money coaching is designed to help people from all walks of life and income to: 1) Build a successful budget and stick to it. 2) Discover easy ways to keep track of your money. 3) Avoid overspend and unmanageable debt. Sometime in May, CAP will be running a Money course in Brightons and if you're interested, please provide your name and details to Roy Graham or Maralyn Stirling. The course runs over 9 modules and is usually 2 hours a week over a 4-week period. It is entirely free and all materials are provided as well as online access to budgeting tools and benefits calculator. You will find flyers in the pews giving more information.
