Youth Development Leader Update

Over the last few months, we have made excellent progress. The committee has prepared the job description, contract, parish profile, advertisement, and detailed budget projection, and drafted additional church policies. The position is officially a "Youth Development Leader", which more accurately communicates the scope of the role. We've appointed and briefed the interview panel and agreed the project management structure. This week we got approval from the Presbytery committee! Unfortunately, we have learned that we also need approval from 121's Ministries Development Staff (MDS) recruitment panel, who next meet on 4th June and report on 13th June. We therefore hope to be able to advertise on 17th June in a number of key locations and on our church website. Please continue to pray for the process, and for the person God is preparing for us.
