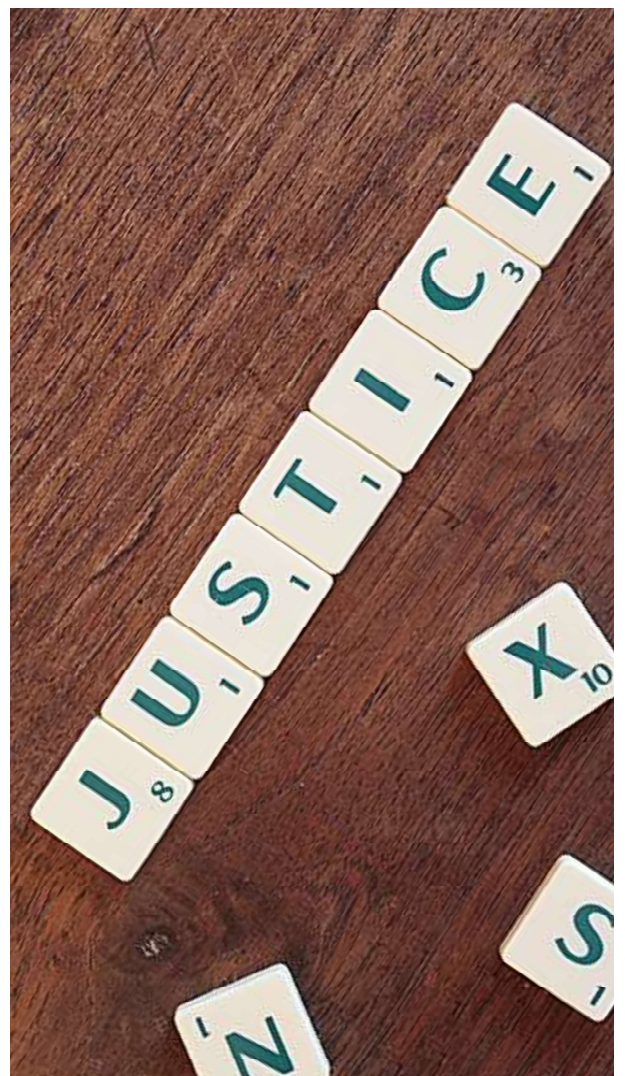


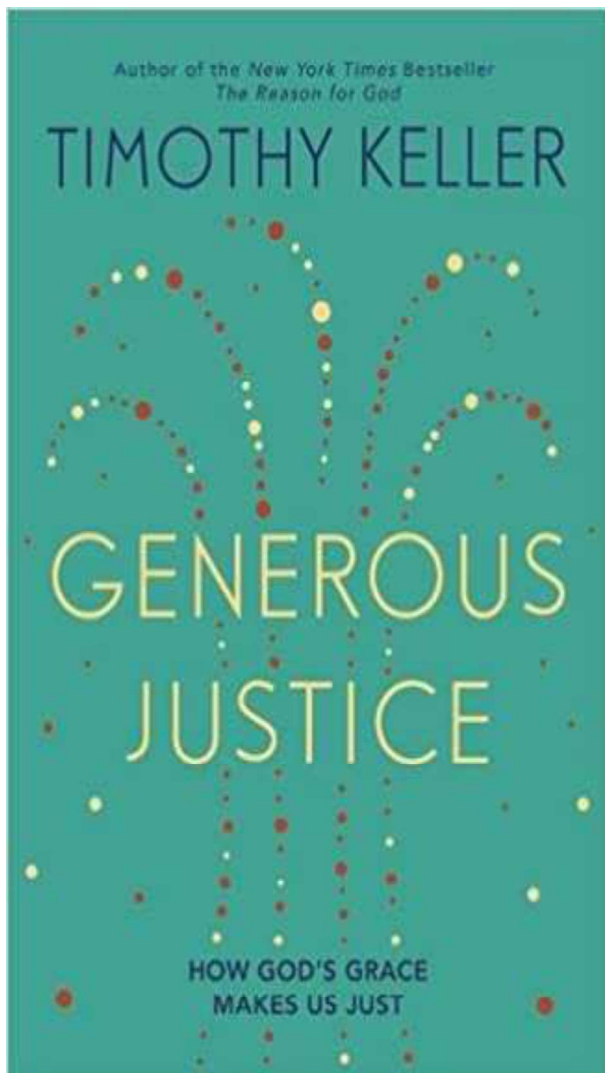

## **Justice: (2) TZADEQAH**

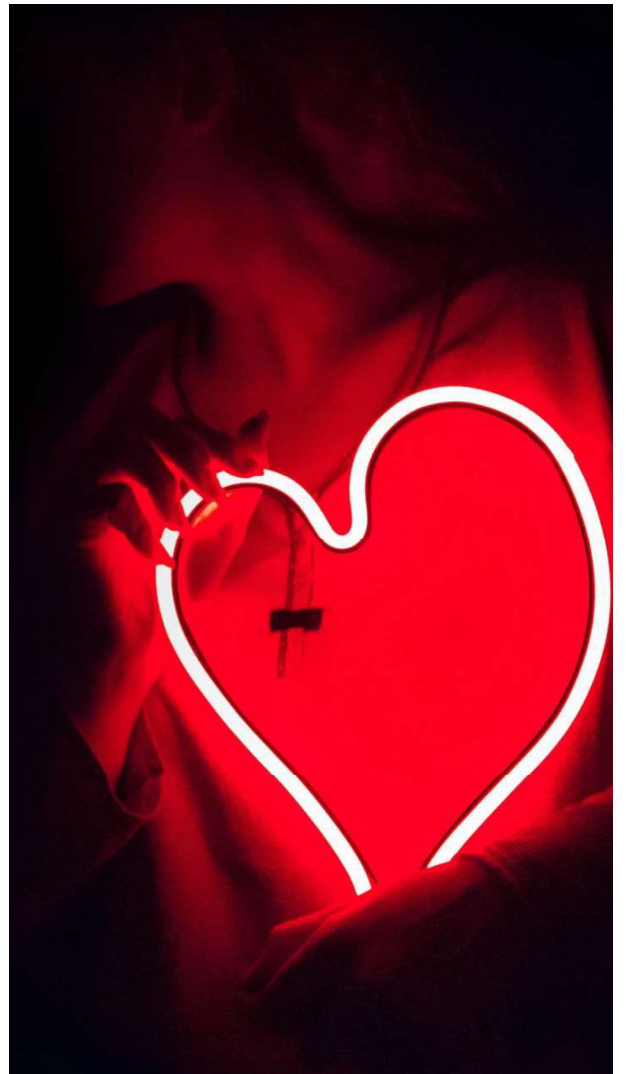
**'living in right

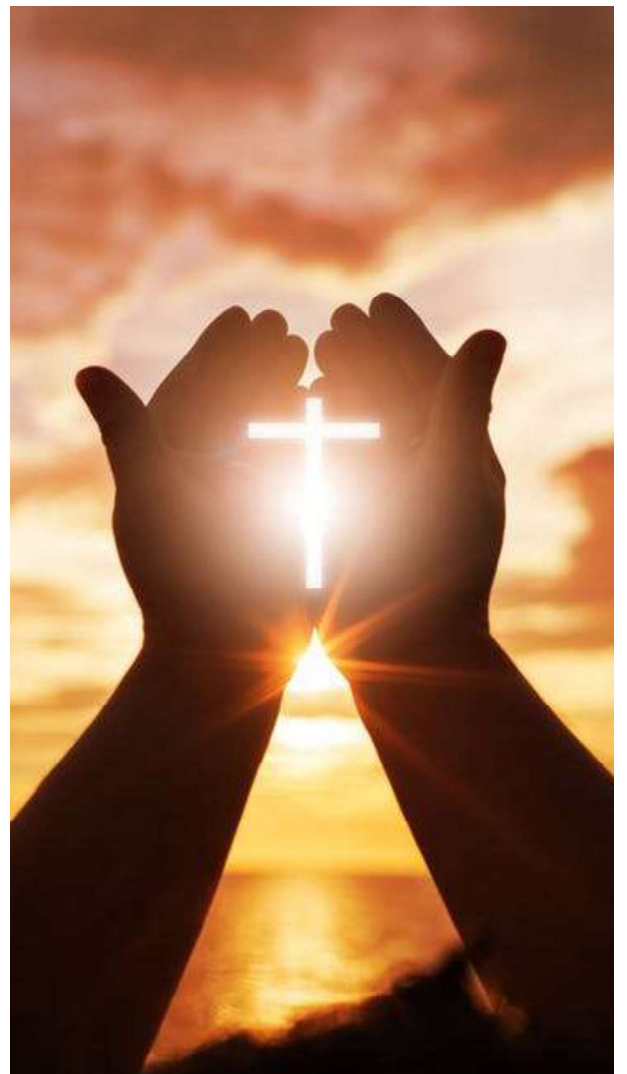
